
The idea was that they would then up date me and hopefully we might be able to start to link members & trees together. Also I have, through people sending me material & also research of my own, compiled a large library of useful material.

COMPUTERS.

Computers are being used more & more in our everyday lives, one of the things they are good at is listing and sorting information. So for genealogy they are an excellent tool.

Since the start of our Society I have been entering all the trees you have sent me and other material

onto a database program especially designed for Family Historians, the programme I use is called Pedigree. I also have several other programs such as Brothers Keeper. I arrived at using Pedigree after looking at nearly every Genealogical

programme that is available & for versatility I can find nothing that gets anywhere near it. There is also a healthy users club which produces a regular magazine, I am the technical co-ordinator for the club. I also know from my last newsletter that there

is another member of our society who is a user and I will be getting in touch with him. It would be useful to me if those of you who are computerised could let me know which machine you are using and which program you use and whether it can import & export in Gedcom(this is the format for data exchanged recognised as the standard in Genealogy, programs without this facility are not worth buying.). There are two reasons it would help me to have this information. 1) I can if you require any information as listed in the General Index send it to you on disc in Gedcom format. 2) I could do with some help, for instance, I have nearly finished entering all names for marriages taken from the St Catherines house registers, I have many such lists and it will literally take me years by myself to enter these. Anyone willing to help please get in touch. I realise it does not help with your immediate research but by getting all this information together it does help you in the long term & it is one of the aims of the socety of which you are a member. If you are buying a computer or a programme I am more than willing to give you any advice that I can. I look forward to hearing from some of you soon.

RESEARCH NEEDED

As a Society members where possible are meant to pass any research they do into the Society and also where there is research needed, offer to help where they can.

With most societies this takes the form of a project dealt with by volunteers. Below is a list of projects that need covering by the Society, if there are any others you can think of let me know.

- Recording of the indexes of the Wills held at Somerset House
- Recording of the Birth, Deaths & Marriages registers at St Catherines House from 1900 to to-day.
- Recording of Non Conformist registers at the P.R.O.

These would all include all variations of the name. On top of this I need help as stated in my piece on computers to enter lists of material I already have.


