The Descendants of Thomas Josselyn and Rebecca.

Abraham Josselyn son of Thomas Josselyn and Rebecca was born in 1619 in London, England and was christened on 6 April 1619. He died on 7 April 1670 in Lancaster, MA. He was a mariner by trade, and attended the Corpus Christi School in London. Abraham died at sea, off the Virginia coast on the ship Ye Good Hope. Abraham married Beatrice Hampson, daughter of Philip Hampson and Jane, on 4 November 1642 in St.Mary's, England. Beatrice was born on 23 July 1623 in London, England and was christened on 15 July 1627 in Holy Trinity, The Less, London. She died on 11 January 1712 in Boston, Suffolk, MA.

Abraham Josselyn and Beatrice Hampson had the following children:

- Abraham Josselyn was born 8 April 1649 and died on 10 Feb 1675/1676.

- Rebecca Josselyn was born in 1655 in Scarboro, Cumberland, Maine. She died in March 1713 in Boston, Suffolk, MA.

- vi. Nathaniel Josselyn was born on 4 July 1660.
- vii. Joseph Josselyn was born 5 May 1663 and died Sept 1726.
- viii. Mary Josselyn was born 14 Oct 1666 in Lancaster, Middlesex, MA.She died on 18 July 1692 in Lancaster, Middlesex, MA.

Henry Josselyn son of Abraham Josselyn and Beatrice was born in 1652 in Scarboro, Cumberland, Maine. He died on 30 Oct 1730 in Hanover, Plymouth, MA and was buried in Hanover, MA. He was a Blacksmith by trade. Henry married Abigail Stockbridge, daughter of Charles Stockbridge and Abigail Pierce, on 4 Nov 1676 in Scituate, Plymouth, MA. Abigail was born on 24 Feb 1660 in Charlestown, Suffolk, MA. She died on 15 July 1743 in Scituate, Plymouth, MA.

According to notes Henry Josselyn was called on the church records "the oldest man in the town for years."

Henry and Abigail had the following children:

- Abraham Josselyn was born on 14 Jan 1678 in Scituate, Ma. He died in 1689 in Scituate.

- iv. Charles Josselyn was born 15 March 1682 and died c. 1749.

- vi. Nathaniel Josselyn was born on 10 Feb 1686 and died in 1726.
- Rebecca Josselyn was born on 25 March 1689 in Scituate and died on 20 April 1689 in Scituate.
- viii. Jabez Josselyn was born 5 Feb 1690 and died on 14 July 1734.
- ix. Rebecca Josselyn was born 14 May 1693 in Scituate.
- Jemima Josselyn was born on 17 Dec 1695 in Scituate. She died 14 Feb 1696 in Scituate.
- xi. Kezia Josselyn was born on 17 Dec 1695 in Scituate.
- xii. Henry Josselyn was born on 24 March 1697 and died c. 1787. (He is a descendant.)
- xiii. Joseph Josselyn was born on 16 Dec 1699 in Scituate. He died 30 April 1787 in Hanover, MA. (The History of the Town of Hanover indicates that Joseph was a great man of enterprise. He gave the town of Hanover the bell now hanging in the Center Meeting House.)
- xiv. Thomas Josselyn was born in Sep 1702 and died on 14 June 1782.

As you can see from the above there are in fact 2 descendants that I can claim from these children I will follow the line of Henry Josselyn born 24 March 1697 first and then the line of Mary Josselyn born 22 Jan 1684 second. You will see in the end where they connect.

Henry Josselyn son of Henry Josselyn and Abigail Stockbridge was born 24 March 1697 in Scituate, MA. He died c. 1787 in Pembroke, MA. Henry married Hannah Oldham, daughter of Isaac Oldham and Hannah Keen, on 23 Sept 1718 in Pembroke, Plymouth, MA. Hannah was born 23 Jun 1700 in Pembroke, MA. She died after 1784 in Pembroke.

Henry and Hannah had the following children:

Charles Josselyn son of Henry Josselyn and Hannah Oldham was born on 7 May 1739 in Pembroke, MA and was christened on 3 Jun 1739 in Pembroke, and died on 21 Nov 1812 in Pembroke. Charles married Rebecca Keen (e) on 10 July 1760 in Pembroke, MA.

Rebecca was born about 1740 in Pembroke, and she died before 4 March 1828 in Pembroke. Charles was one of the first members of the First Church of Pembroke, Mass. as shown in the Church records. He also responded to the Lexington alarm in Capt. Turner's Company, Massachusetts Militia.

Charles was engaged in the iron business at Sylvester's Forge (anchor manufacturer). Charles married Lucy M. Dwelley, daughter of Jedediah Dwelley and Lydia Soule, on 14 Nov 1770 in Pembroke. She died on 20 April 1829 in Pembroke, and was buried in Center Pembroke.

Cyrus Barker Josselyn son of Charles Josselyn and Lucy Dwelley was born on 2 Oct 1814 in Pembroke, Ma. He died on 13 June 1898 in Hanover, Ma and was buried in Jun 1898 in Hanover Center. Cyrus married Elizabeth Barker Bates daughter of Thomas Merit Bates and Sylvia Wing, on 24 Oct 1833 in Hanover, MA. Elizabeth was born on 21 Jun 1811 in Hanover. She died on 27 Jan in Hanover, where she is buried.

Cyrus resided on School Street, Hanover, Ma, in the house constructed by himself, and later owned and occupied by his son, Lewis. Cyrus was an iron founder, shoe manufacturer, and farmer. According to the 1870 Hanover census, he had real estate worth \$3,000 and his personal belongings were worth \$800.

Lewis married Ella Frances Sampson, daughter of Byram Sampson and Esther H. Cox, 24 Dec 1871 in Hanson, Plymouth, Ma. Ella was born on 22 Mar 1851 in Hanson, and she died on 17 Dec 1877 in Hanover, Ma. She was buried in Fem Hill Cemetery, Hanson, MA.

The Quincy Patriot Ledger, dated Feb 16, 1944, reads as follows: "Last Civil War Vet in County is Dead at 101—Hanover, Feb 16- Lewis Josselyn, last surviving veteran of the Civil War in Plymouth County, died yesterday after several weeks illness at the age of 101. Mr. Josselyn was a charter member and past Commander of the Joseph E. Wilder post, G.A.R. He was also an honorary member of the Josselyn-Cummings Legion Post, named in honor of his son, Leon, who was killed in the last war, and of the Old Colon post, V.F.W. of Rockland. In the Civil War, he was a member of Co. K, 38th Regiment, Massachusetts Infantry Volunteers. He was in the grocery business here for many years, having retired in 1916. Leon Josselyn was the son of his second marriage to Mabel (Corlew) Josselyn. (Entire Article not included) There is also a Civil War Journal and a Journal of his trip to California July 22, 1886.

Gordon Sullivan is President and Chief Operating Officer of the Association of the United States Army, headquartered in Arlington, VA. He assumed his current position at the Association in Feb 1998 after serving as President, Coleman, Federal, Washington, D.C. The son of Russell and Penuel (Gordon) Sullivan, he was commissioned a second lieutenant of Armor and awarded a Bachelor of Arts degree in history from Norwich University in 1959. He holds a Master of Arts degree in political science from the University of New Hampshire. His professional military education includes the U.S. Army Armor School Basic and Advanced Course, the Command and General Staff College, and the Army War College. Gordon retired from the Army on 31 July 1995 after more than 36 years of active service. He culminated his service of uniform as the 32nd Chief of Staff- the senior general officer in the Army-and a member of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. As the Chief of Staff of the Army, he created the vision and led the team that transformed the Army from its Cold War posture. He is the co-author, with Michael V. Harper, of Hope is Not a Method, (Random House, 1996), which chronicles the enormous challenges encountered in transforming the post-Cold War Army through the lens of proven leadership principles and a commitment to shared values. 



He gave a great deal of service during the Revolutionary War., enlisted 1st on April 19,1775 on an alarm at Marshfield and later in 1780 for 5months 13 days.
