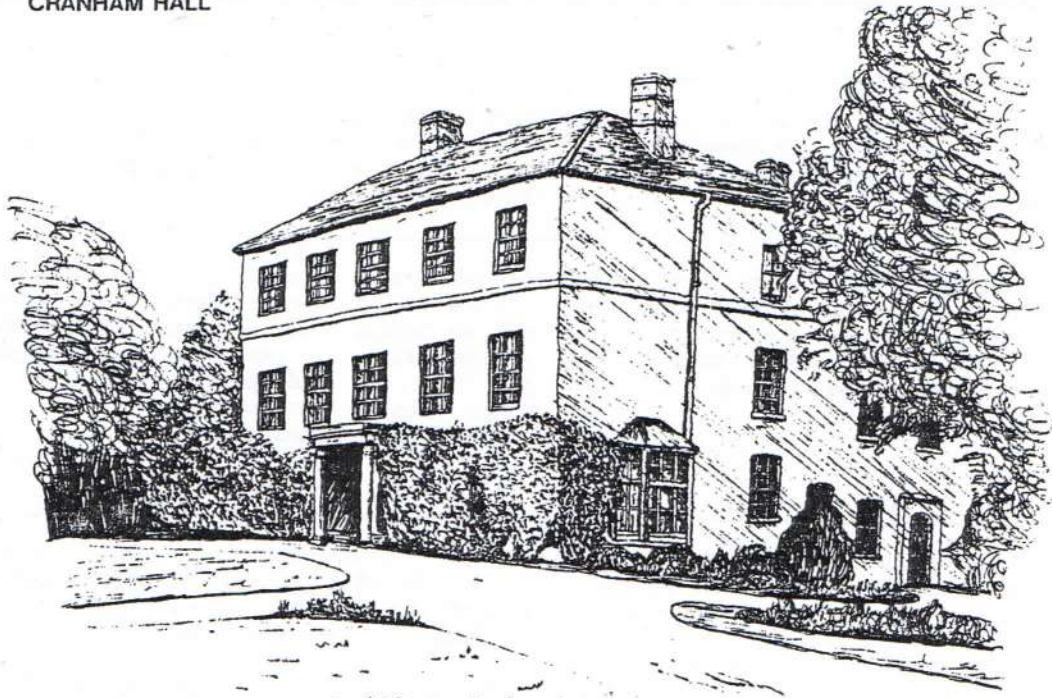

CRANHAM HALL

Situated near the church, Cranham Hall is built on part of the old manor of Cranham Hall or Crawehehalle, as it was once known. Records show that on his death in 1229 it was held by Nicolas de Halughton on knights service from the Bishop of London. In 1442 by the service of 30s. a year it was held, together with the advowson of the church, by Sir Lodowic John of West Horden. One well known historic figure who was granted the manor in 1471, was Richard, Duke of Gloucester, who later became Richard III and reputed murderer of his two nephews in the Tower. It was later sold to Sir Willaim Petre of Ingatestone Hall who on his death passed it to his son John. The manor remained in this family until its purchase by Nathan Wright, whose daughter Susan married as her second husband that great player of bowls, Sir Francis Drake. In 1741 the manor was passed to Elizabeth, descendant of Nathan Wright, who married in 1744 General James Oglethorpe of Westbrook in Surrey. Renowned for his outspokenness, as member of Parliament for Haslemere, one of his early projects was Prison reform. A later event was the foundation of the Colony of Georgia in 1732. In the Battle of Bloody Marsh, Oglethorpe, with a small band of supporters, managed to defeat the Spanish. He returned to England because of illness and after his marriage spent many relaxing times at Cranham Hall, although he was twice court martialled and later acquitted for various misdemeanours. During his lifetime his friends, Oliver Goldsmith, Dr. Johnson and Boswell made frequent visits to his home. His last appointment in 1768 was Surveyor of the Roads in Upminster. He died in 1785 and was buried in All Saints church.

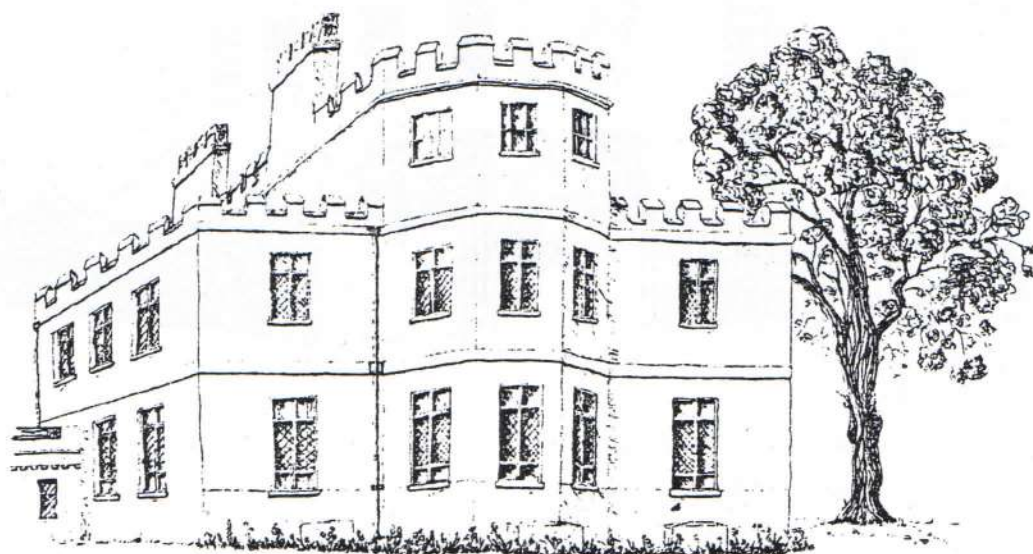
The present house, built in the early 19th. century, stands on the site of a much larger Hall. The style is typical of the period with sash windows and the pillared porch at the entrance door. The house has been extended and altered over the years but still retains its original outward appearance. In 1937 it was purchased by Southend on Sea Estate Co. and is now farmed and tenanted by Mr. T. Everard.

HARWOOD HALL

Lying back from Harwood Hall Lane and hidden by a brick wall is the interesting house called Harwood Hall. Built in 1782 by Sir James Esdaile for his son-in-law George Stubbs, the lands extend to the Aveley Road. There is evidence of a previous house.

In 1801 the occupant of the house was Sir Thomas Barrett Lennard. Having first moved to Hactons in Upminster on his marriage to Dorothy St. Aubyns, in 1787, he took up residence for only a short period of time at a rent of £180. He moved to Belhus, the family estate in 1804.

Held by Joslin, 1881.

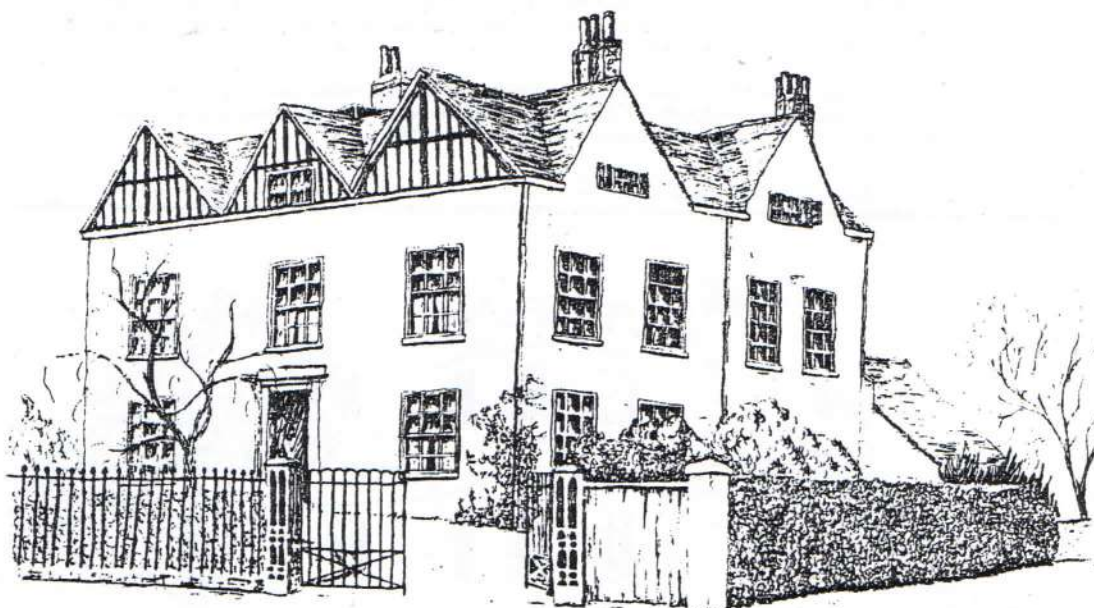
Following the death of Peter Esdaile, the Gaynes Estate was split up and sold, Harwood Hall was purchased in 1819 by Captain Philip Zachariah Cox, a soldier in the 3rd. Dragoons and a veteran of the Napoleonic Wars. On his death in 1858 it was left together with Fox Hall to A. Z. Button, who later changed his name to Cox.

Harwood Hall has had many occupants and for a short period, prior to 1877 it was the residence of Col. Henry Holmes who then moved to his new house Grey Towers, Hornchurch. This building has since been demolished, but I was struck by the similarity of the architectural design. Both have the embattled structure and enclosed entrance hall.

A recent owner was Mr. Fisk who founded the Thames Boardmills at Purfleet. The present owner is Mr. Claude F. Mead J.P. who purchased the property in 1954 with the intention of rebuilding a modern dwelling on the site. On discovering that the structure was completely sound, the old house was renovated instead to form this pleasant residence.

The interior walls of the house are very thick and one room is completely dominated by a fine Adam ceiling, beautifully preserved. In the centre of this ceiling is a rare Adam painting depicting a mother and child with a rearing horse in the background. This room and the one adjoining also contain Adam fireplaces.

Under the house is a small stream which was probably once the only water supply to the house. Although it still flows it does not appear to cause any dampness to the structure. During the demolition of Belhus in Aveley the present owner purchased bricks to build the lodge at the West Gate. The gardens and grounds are spacious and well laid out and in one part an Indoor Equestrian Arena has been built. Run by the owners daughter, Miss Cindy Mead, it has been used as a competition centre for many of the well known show jumpers of this country.

HUNTS

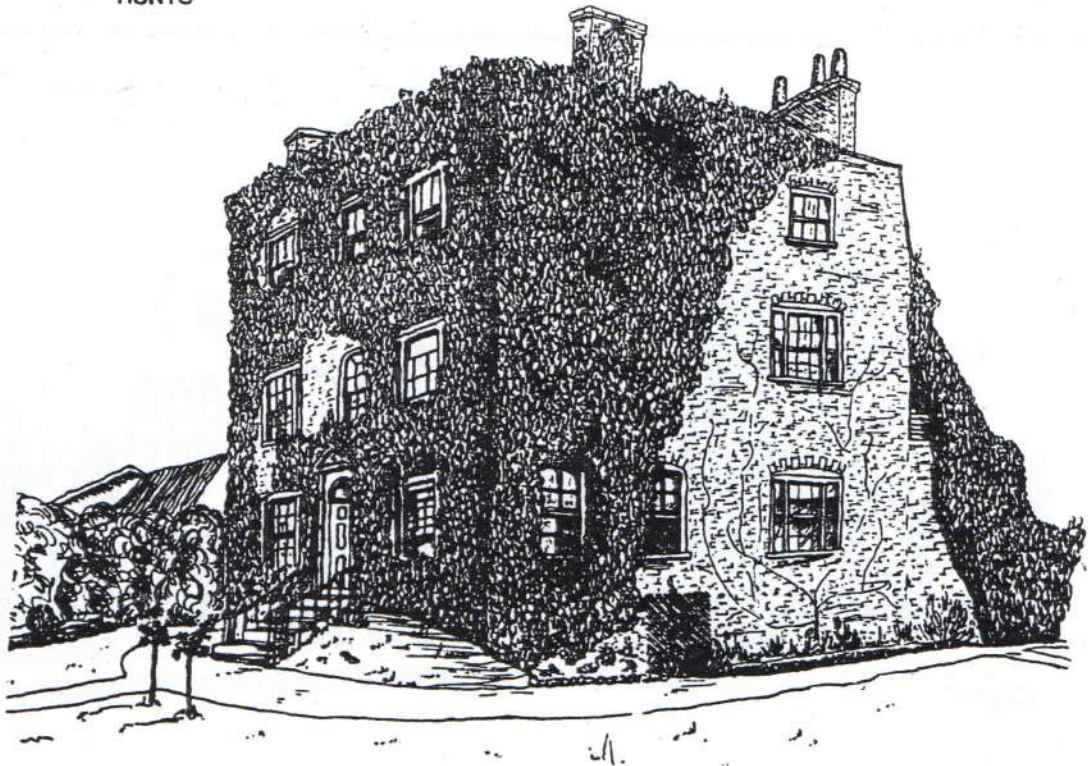
This square imposing house was built, together with many other houses in Upminster, by Sir James Esdaile in 1775. The fact that so much building was undertaken in the area at this time must have proved a valuable source of employment for the local villagers. Although only a farmhouse, the building was large, tall and in later years completely covered with climbing plants.

The site was held in 1673 by Sir Benjamin Wright of Cranham Hall, whose name has frequently occurred as owning other properties in and around Upminster. In 1729, when it comprised a house with 30 acres of land, it was owned by another member of this family, Sir Nathan Wright.

The new house remained in the possession of the Esdaile family until more of the Gaynes manor was sold in 1839, when it was purchased by William Colls. One tenant during this period was James Nokes who built Upminster Windmill.

So many of the names mentioned as owners of property in Upminster appear again and again and Hunts is no exception, as in 1890 it was bought by Henry Joslin of Hoppy Hall. It was occupied by his brother Walter, who farmed 130 acres surrounding the house. On his death in 1937, the building was demolished and the site at the corner of Springfield Gardens is now occupied by a row of shops.

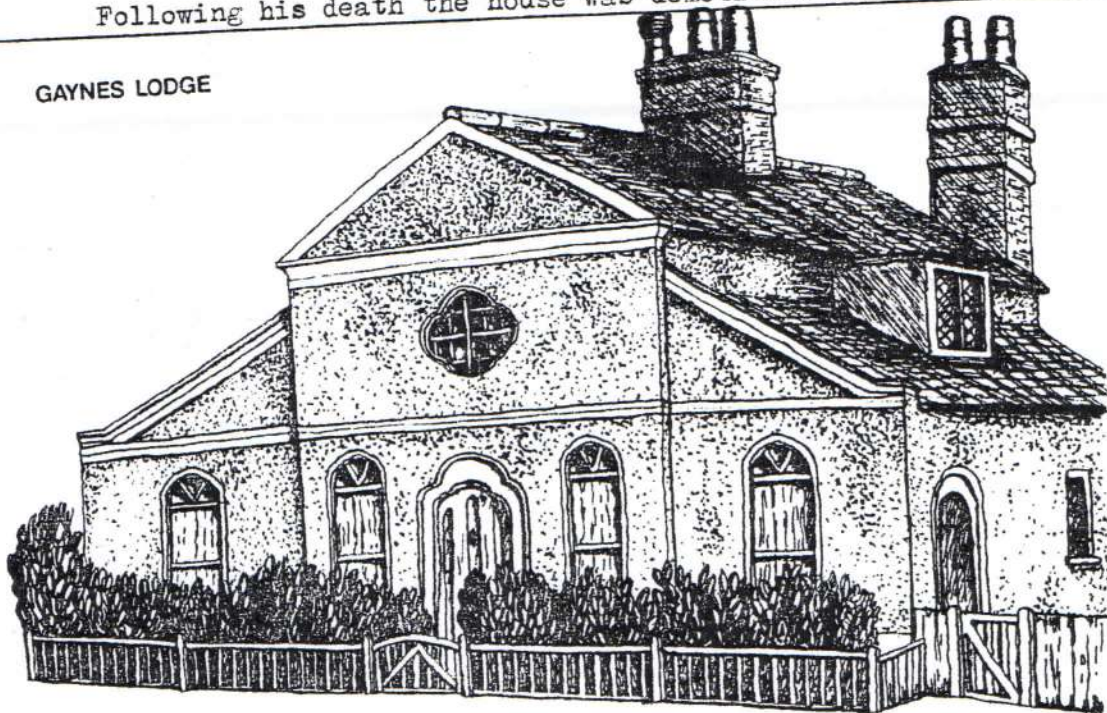
Hunts,- Held by Walter Joslin,

GAINES

Another of the manors of Upminster was Gaines, also spelt Gaynes. The grounds of the house stretched from Little Gaynes Lane to Harwood Hall Lane. From the time of Edward the Confessor it was in the possession of Suene Suart. Although it was confirmed to him at the time of the Conquest in 1066, twenty years later, according to the Domesday Book, it was held by Walter de Doai, being some 940 acres valued at £8.

The name derives from the family de Engen or Engaine, originally coming from Engen near Boulogne, with William the Conqueror. In 1242 Vitalis Engaine acquired the manor which he held in serjeantry of keeping the king's greyhounds. The manor remained in this family until the death of the last male, Sir Thomas Engaine in 1367. Alice Perrers, the famous mistress of Edward III in his old age, is recorded to have held the manor of Gaynes in 1377, but on the death of her husband, Sir William Windsor, Lord Lieutenant of Ireland, in 1383, it passed to Sir John Deyncourt.

By 1543 the manor was in the possession of Ralph Latham who also owned Upminster Hall. During the succeeding years, Gaines had many owners, until 1760, when it was purchased by Sir James Esdaile, who was descended from an old French family. Sir James was a banker and a man of wealth. He ordered the demolition of the previous building and construction of an elegant mansion and grounds. On his death in 1793 it passed to his son and heir, Peter Esdaile but by 1820 the estate had been sold in lots and most of the buildings taken down.

In 1821 the Rev. John Clayton erected a smaller dwelling near the site of the old house. His son George, who also followed the Nonconformist ministry, was renowned for his preaching and interest in the people of Upminster. The last mansion to survive was built for him in 1846. He died in 1862 and his widow remarried Henry Joslin and the estate was purchased by him in 1877. On his death in 1927 the last remaining house was demolished and the grounds redeveloped.
